Re: Education Assistance

In order for Post-Secondary students to be sponsored by the Shackan Band Education Department, providing funding is available, and meet with the Guidelines 2019-2020 from Indigenous Services Canada, the following is required:

- Letter of intent describing the program you plan to take in continuing your education.
- Transcript from the school you last attended.
- A letter of acceptance from the College of University you applied to attend school.
- Shackan Band application for Education Assistance Form completed and returned.
- Conditions of Educational Assistance Waiver Form completed and returned.
- Plus, a copy of your grade 12 report card, or Diploma.
- Your complete package of application must be in office by April 30, 2020.

Once I have all the above on file, you will then be notified if there is funding available.

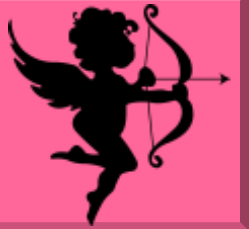
